- Highlights of Permitted Activities:**
- Hiking, Cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, horseback riding.
 - Off Road motorized vehicles permitted only with a valid permit on designated trails.

- Pets must be under control or on leash at all times
- Hunting permitted in accordance with provincial regulations except on several tracts which are in close proximity to urban areas.


- Highlights of Prohibited Activities:**
- Operation of motor vehicles (cars and trucks)
 - Open fires; camping
 - Target practice; paintball
 - Construction of unauthorized structures; permanent tree stands
 - Placement of unauthorized signs
 - Consumption of alcohol
 - Littering, dumping or disposal of any foreign material
 - Cutting, pruning, digging or gathering of trees, shrubs, groundcover or firewood.











