TAY is located on the southern shore of Georgian Bay, home of the 30,000 Islands. Canoeing, kayaking, swimming, boating, go tubing, seadooring, fishing, sailing, or just sit by the shore and take it in, you name it, Georgian Bay has it all.



The **Tay Shore Trail** boasts over 18 kilometers of paved trail that meanders along the pristine shores of Georgian Bay showcasing glorious vistas of the Bay, the Wye, Hogg and Sturgeon Rivers. Perfect for roller blading, biking, walking, running and is fully accessible. Interpretive plaques along the trail display the local wildlife, terrain and Tay's rich history. Known as the Cadillac of trails, the Tay Shore Trail is a must.



Port McNicoll Adventures is an exciting marine and outdoor recreational and activities centre. Enjoy personal water crafts (seadoo / jet-ski / waverunners), fishing boats, kayaks and tubing. They also offer a 30,000 Islands guided tour of Georgian Bay.

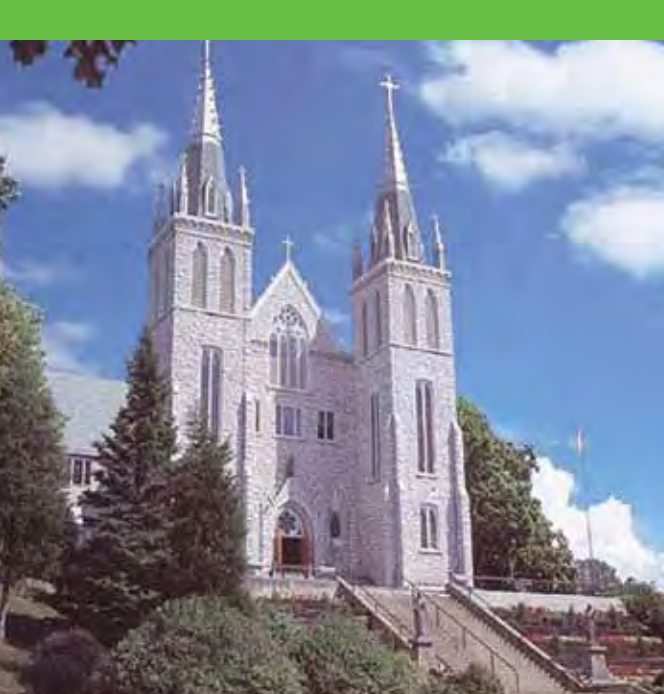

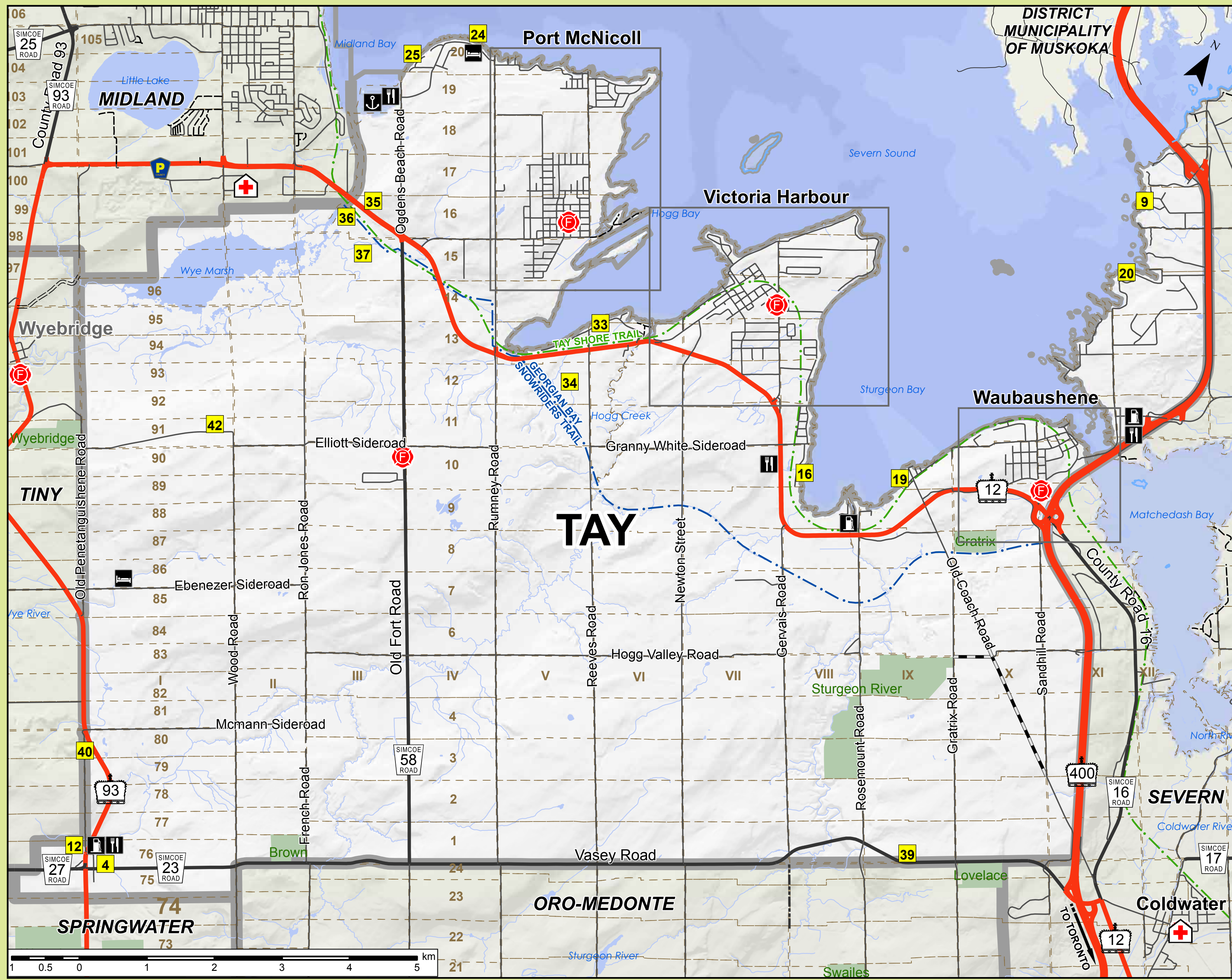
Horseback Riding is available at Highview Farms and Equestrian Centre and at El Rancho. Enjoy scenic trail rides and full equestrian services including lessons. Whether you're looking for adventure or the peaceful enjoyment of nature and the bond between horse and rider, horseback riding is a wonderful experience.



Sainte-Marie among the Hurons is a recreated, 17th century French Jesuit mission headquarters where you can experience the interaction of the French and native Wendat Huron nation. Follow in the footsteps of Ontario's first Europeans at Sainte-Marie among the Hurons, a unique time in Canadian history when French missionaries lived and worked among the Wendat. It's a rare chance to see the earliest in Canadian pioneer life through guided or self-guided visits. Sainte-Marie among the Hurons will shed light on one of the earliest examples of the introduction of Christianity into Aboriginal culture.



The **Martyrs' Shrine** honours the eight Jesuit saints who lived, worked and died there over 350 years ago. The grounds, including the famous Shrine Church and 75 pleasantly landscaped acres invite you into prayer and tranquility. Visit and learn about the Jesuit missionaries, Jean de Brébeuf, Gabriel Lalemant, and their companions who were responsible for bringing Christianity to Canada over 350 years ago.



Gratrix Garden Lilies has a collection of superb lily, daylily, and peony varieties available for purchase and visit their display garden and enjoy the scent and the rainbow of rich colours that floods ones senses in such a way that makes it impossible to reproduce.



The **Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre** is nature at it's best! You're invited to leap into a nature experience you will always remember. Take a leisurely walk in the woods or mountain bike. They have 25 kilometers of cross country track set trails and snowshoe trails and rental equipment. The Wye Marsh is designated as an important birding area and home to many rare species of mammals, reptiles and birds that can

be seen while walking their extensive boardwalk network over the marsh. The majestic Trumpeter Swans make their home at the Marsh, thanks to a successful repopulation program started there in the 1980's. The Wye Marsh has canoe and kayaking tours along with many other activities and special events. It's a wonderful place that you will want to visit again and again.
